We track the Internet address of people who visit uk.fujitsu.com and analyse this data for trends and statistics, but the tracked data does not include your Personal Data. Other Fujitsu Group websites may collect your Personal Data in compliance with applicable laws and regulations; please refer to the privacy policy on the specific Fujitsu Group website to see how your Personal Data is handled. If you do not provide the information we request, you can still visit most of our website but you may be unable to access certain options, offers and services.

Some Fujitsu Group websites send "cookies" to your computer to better serve you with more tailored information when you return to the website. Cookies are identifiers that include unique characters, but unless you input your Personal Data onto our website you cannot be identified and remain anonymous. You can set most browsers to tell you when you are sent a cookie and to refuse to receive it.

Cookies

A cookie is a small piece of code which is sent from our servers to your computer. It does not contain any personal information and is used to improve the functionality on the website and also to anonymously track user visits, to enable us to improve the overall user experience by making improvement to the website.

With the exception of our website forms and site search, cookies are sent to your computer only with your express consent. When you visit a Fujitsu website you will be asked whether or not you wish to allow the use of cookies. If you do not consent, no cookies will be set.

On form pages, cookies are used to temporarily store data to enable to process of form submission. These are not used for identification or tracking purposes and no data are stored in the cookies after you close your browser. By submitting a form on a Fujitsu website, you are consenting to allow these temporary cookies to be set. The same applies to the site search, which temporarily uses an anonymous cookie to enable relevant search results to be returned.
